Introduction to hand embroidery – With Kate Farrer - Saturday the 28th of March – 10am-4pm. Class cost £75.00 plus class kit at £15.00

Whether you're a complete beginner or just a bit 'rusty' this is a great place to start. Introduction to Embroidery will introduce you to a wide range of stitches.

Introduction to Jacobean- With Lizzy Lansberry - Saturday the 4th of April – 10am – 4pm. Class cost £75.00 plus class kit at £22.00

Ideal for beginners, Jacobean Crewelwork was developed in the 17th Century and uses a range of stitches in crewel wool worked on linen. The design will include the most commonly used stitches.
